


Shalom's Vision

Jclub Ministry: There is no such coincidence in the life of a child of God. Like what I shared with you in my previous letter, that there was a couple who wanted to come and serve God with us. We established Jclub- an English center. A language center is a good door for evangelism. It can provide visas, jobs and opportunities to reach out to many people. In June 2024, after 3 months of construction, we started to have our first students. Everything seemed to be going quite smoothly, but after 3 months, the number of students was not enough to cover the cost. The couple felt pressured and asked me to return their investment and left. I felt very sad and disappointed but thank God for giving me the faith and strength to continue to stay and fight because I believe that God has a purpose in everything and this is just a test of faith.

Instead of being discouraged, we prayed and worked harder. Although there were not many students, God still had His way of providing for His work. The best thing I received was the lessons and sincere friends. Because we did not give up easily, God opened wonderful doors for us. We would like to thank the pastors and the church for their prayers and support.

Christmas Evangelism: There were more than 40 people attending the Christmas evangelism, 5 people got saved and 1 person got baptized.

At the mission work in Ninh Thuan for them Cham people, we were able to share the Gospel with more than 100 children. Last month, My family had a 2 weeks mission trip in central Vietnam. I am so glad that my siblings and my wife's family have been very involved in the ministry.

After nearly 9 years of missionary work in Da Lat, I realized that God is using us through the path of education, teaching the younger generation. English is a great tool. beside teaching at Christian school, I have had many opportunities to work as an interpreter for local authorities, teaching English to many ages from college students, children in public schools and even business owners. They need to see God through our lives.
