
THE BISWASES

- In April, another youth camp was held and this time it was in an Shiliguri, India. Joseph was assigned to help a few churches there organize their first-ever camp. By His grace, 40 campers decided to put their faith in Jesus as the only way to heaven among 150 campers.
- The highlight of April was the special celebration of Jesus' Resurrection in our church as it is unusual in Bangladesh for Sunday to be everyone's day off. On Sundays in Bangladesh, children go to school and adults go to work. Besides having a Sunday worship service, kids had a special Easter program to remember the importance of Jesus' resurrection in the afternoon until evening.
- In May, God helped Joseph and his team of camp staff were able to meet connections in Chittagong to arrange a Youth Camp in August. We praise God for the positive response of churches there who agreed to let CampsAbroad have a camp there.
- On the last Friday of June, we praise God for the four professions of faith in Jesus among the young people who came to our Youth Lunch Fellowship.

Some of our prayer requests remain the same:

- God's provision of about \$400 monthly for a decent place of worship since we meet at home to have our worship service.
