Our school is continuing to grow. And through it all, God is supplying our needs, even during this dark time in Myanmar. Education is always one of the great challenges that parents face in Myanmar. But we thank God for His enabling grace, using our church to provide a good education for our church children. Our kids really enjoy the ACE Paces. Many Christian parents from all over Yangon call regularly and ask if our Church can accept students from outside our church. Due to the political unrest, many parents don't want to send their kids to public school anymore. Our church is helping 10 children who cannot afford a private school and have no opportunity for a proper education. Most of those parents have been saved, along with their children, and are now attending our church regularly.



We thank God for every opportunity to serve the Lord in Myanmar and to minister to our people. My family is especially grateful for your faithful partnership in reaching the lost in the Golden Land. Please continue to pray for us!
