Dear PASTOR YAN TEE WEE and Partner In Missions,

We have known of some very trying situations that others are going through and our hearts certainly go out to them. We know that the Lord is faithful and that we can trust in Him, no matter what the situation is. I am reminded of words that the Lord gave to Jeremiah, the prophet to write in a letter to the captives that were carried away from Jerusalem to Babylon. Although, it would take 70 years for the captivity to end, the Lord assured them that He had a purpose in allowing it. **Jeremiah 29:11 says:** "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the Lord, thoughts of peace, and not evil, to give you an expected end".

So, I talked to her about what the church is all about or its meaning? And who baptized her? I found out that she was baptized in a church that has no authority at all. She told me that she's observing our church and looking for a church with sound doctrine. I think she found Bethany Baptist Church by God's grace. I talked and explained to her about membership and finally, she fully learned the importance of membership. She and her son were beaten hard during this pandemic, and still, they praise God for blessing them to sell some stuff in front of their old wooden tiny house and sometimes selling vegetables in front of the market. Despite their difficulties and financial situations, I didn't hear any complaints from them unlike other people and sometimes old-time Christians. Even though she was not yet a member but she has consistently coming to our church riding her bicycle with her son. And they even gave their tithes, offerings, and love gifts to our church. **Please do pray for them as they continue to seek God's will in their lives.**

My family is doing well by God's enabling grace. Jared is working excellent in his studies.
