The first quarter of this year went by so fast, to say the least but we praise God for allowing us to carry on with His ministry. **January 29**, a Korean friend introduced to us **Ms. Uyen**. She comes from Hue city, the central part of Vietnam. Being an English major student in one of the national universities there, she speaks the language quite well. We would find out later, according to her testimony, that one of her vices, among others is that she is a chain smoker. She said that she has basically no direction in life. She stopped going to the university. She had no idea what she wanted in life. Before coming to Saigon, she distanced herself from almost everybody for an entire year. Her entire day would be spent alone in her room not knowing what is happening with herself.

January 30, she attended church for the first time in her life! Everything was strange to her. The Bible was something she got curious about, but in a good way. After the service, she said I want to know more about that book. I have never read a book of such kind. **February 5**, we started a Bible study with her and it has been going on until now. She has not missed a church service since then. **March 20**, during the church invitation, she raised her hand signifying she wanted to be saved. I wanted to give her time to make sure that she knew what she was doing when she raised her hand. **March 26**, Saturday, we had a special service because the next day, most of our Filipino members would cross the Vietnam-Cambodia border for visa purposes after being closed for two years! My wife and I asked **Ms. Uyen** to come early so we could talk to her. I asked her why she raised her hand the other Sunday. These were her exact words: "I want to be with God." We reviewed what we have been studying on how to have a personal relationship with God because that only way to God is Jesus Christ. It was an evening full of good emotions as she trusted the work of the Lord Jesus Christ on the cross, confessed and repented of her sins and asked God to forgive her. **Ms. Uyen** got saved on that special Saturday worship service! Praise the Lord! He is still in the business of saving souls! We already have started our lesson on baptism and I am looking forward to the day that **Ms. Uyen** will join the church!

Thank you **Pastor Wee**, for allowing us to represent you here. We would not exchange for anything in the world for what God is allowing us to do here in Saigon, all by His grace. Surely, we miss all of you and are looking forward to the time where we can all fellowship again in the near future!
