

#### The God Who Makes All Things Possible

We serve a miracle-working God and our first 3 months of staying here in the field serves as a powerful reminder of that. I would like to once again express our gratitude to you for your faithfulness in holding the rope for us through prayers and financial support. Because of God's power working through you, we were able to weather the first few months of being in Japan. It has not been easy adjusting to the very nuanced culture and high standard of living in a first-world country such as Japan. Our current support is just enough for a single person yet somehow, God miraculously provides for our needs over and over again. We were able to rent a 60m2 apartment that is lower than its usual price and comes with free internet. But the most surprising part is we're able to rent despite us being foreign missionaries. For further context, it takes a long time for you to be accepted in the local community. No matter how fluent or knowledgeable you become, more often that not, you will always be treated as an "outsider" here. Foreigners are tolerated but not really accepted. There's a story of a Japanese couple who moved to the opposite end of their area, and it took them years to be "accepted" by the community. You can't get more Japanese than they are and so imagine the case for us foreigners. But we're not just foreigners here. We're foreign missionaries. Japan's culture is deeply embedded to their Shintoist-Buddhist religion. And so, telling them about the Gospel is seen as a direct attack to the very fiber of their being. Add to the fact that a couple of years back, the assassination of former PM Shinzo Abe is being indirectly linked to the suspect's mom, who is being blamed for being part of the Unification Church, which caused distress and trauma for him to commit the act. So in our case, being a foreigner plus a missionary are already two strikes. This is when God showed His power. After a good number of rejections in our rent application (including outright denials), God orchestrated a way for us to use JBBF (Japan Baptist Bible Fellowship) and Inage Bible Baptist Church as our guarantor. So when the rental company e-mailed us to let us know that our application was approved we were so happy because it is the 2nd time in the history of JBBF that it happened. Japan is unbending and notorious in sticking to its old ways. Yet our God, the author of all creation, is far greater and more powerful than any centuries-long form of government. This is a reminder for us that while the hearts of the Japanese may seem impenetrable with the Gospel, we have God on our side. The God

So, while we may feel the clouds of discouragement as we reach out to the seemingly hard-to-reach locals, we are thankful that we have the very words of our Lord Jesus Christ to help us encourage ourselves in the Lord, knowing very well that as He calls, He enables.

#### Life in Inage Bible Baptist Church

We thank God for the Barleys and Inage Bible Baptist Church for their love and care for us since we set foot here in Japan. The members at Inage have graciously provided some furniture and kitchenware in our place so that we didn't have to buy them. We are currently partnering with them (they were the ones who sponsored our visa) for a year or so until we are able to speak the Japanese language and have a decent understanding of the culture. My wife and I help in the music ministry, playing the flute and violin during Sunday services. I do the songleading during Wednesdays.



My wife also teaches violin to a young lady in the church. Lord-willing, I will soon be able to help set up the church's media ministry (livestream, translation, etc.) and, once my Japanese is "bearable," I will also be able to teach and preach. Because the congregation is mainly Japanese, the services are also in Japanese. One of the church ladies, Sis. Maki, has been helping us learn both the Japanese language and the Japanese Christian language, 3 times a week. This leads me to a very urgent prayer request. I am praying to enroll in a formal Japanese language school by August. However, it is quite expensive and since we are barely making ends meet with our support, I am praying that God will provide for it. The cost is about \$4000 for 1 semester, and the schooling will take about 2 years. Our heart's desire is to reach the Japanese for Christ, and being fully equipped in this area will bring us closer to reaching that goal. We have been able to hand out tracts to the locals and even gave gifts to our neighbors (with tracts inside them), but with our current level of Japanese, we are unable to further the conversation. Please pray that God will use these tracts to speak to their hearts and minds about their need for a Savior. Also, we're conducting 2 online Bible studies every week for Filipinos here in the far areas of Japan, especially those that don't have a church to attend to. If you know other Filipinos that desperately need the feeding of God's Word please let us know and we'll be glad to minister to them and if possible, visit them in God's perfect time. That would be all for this time. Brethren, thank you for all that you do for the Lord, and for us. Soon, by God's wonder-working power, we will be able to reap fruits, and fruits that remain. God bless you.
